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Whisky Tasting Notes:

Hellyers Road Original 10yr

Nose: Butterscotch, pear drops, vanilla. Hints of barley sugar, rich honey and malt

Palate: Delicate vanilla, citrus fruits, toasted yet balanced sweetness, touch of maple spice

Finish: Medium, hints of sweet oak, maple syrup and allspice

Hellyers Road Peated

Nose: Woody, oily, soft wood smoke. Hints of citrus zest, white pepper, peppermint, melting butter.

Palate: Apple peel, rich fruity peat. Hint of salinity. Chipotle spice, linseed oil, sweet and savoury balance, malt compliments the peat nicely

Finish: Long, oily, rich.

Hellyers Road Pinot Noir Finish

Nose: Buttery, biscuity, malty aromas. Hints of Pina Colada, allspice, tropical fruit. Underlying fruit character, honeyed and inviting.

Palate: Sweet and rich, strawberry jam and cracked black pepper. Oily with blackcurrant and nutmeg notes.

Finish: Short-to-medium, sweet fruity honey.

Hellyers Road Port Cask 12 yr

Nose: Heavily wooded forest, fresh and pure

Palate: Sweet and soft feel, dried herbs, spice

Finish: Crepes, stewed stone fruit, cinnamon dusting

Overeem Port Cask

Nose: Notes of chocolate-chip cookie, cloves, orange marmalade

Palate: Spice, dried dark fruits (raisin and date)

Finish: Plum, sultana, cocoa

Sullivans Cove Double Cask

Nose: Soft fruit, ripe pears, honey, vanilla

Palate: Soft feel, ripe pears, chocolate, caramel, honey, vanilla

Finish: Medium with hints of chocolate

Belgrove Rye

Nose: Buttery, ripe tropical fruits and durian, grainy, fresh dough, sultanas, jelly beans, Christmas spice, soft florals

Palate: Grainy yet malty, green wood, chocolate, vanilla, almonds, green walnuts, wet hay

Finish: Long, warm, spicy, oily, grainy attitudes

Whisky Tasting Notes:

Mackey Triple Distilled Single Malt

Nose: Initial sweet and floral perfumed notes, fragrant sugars and soft fruits, sweet malts and brown creaming soda.

Palate: Sweet malts, citrus peel, dried and tangy flavours of apple and dark stone fruits with tart cherries.

Finish: The whisky is dry enough to evaporate in the mouth and flood the sinuses, crawling over the tongue in a caterpillar fashion of sweet toasted fragrant flowers before slipping off and disappearing.
